Spring Fling will be June 21 at Jamie's house. We will have more details at the May meeting.

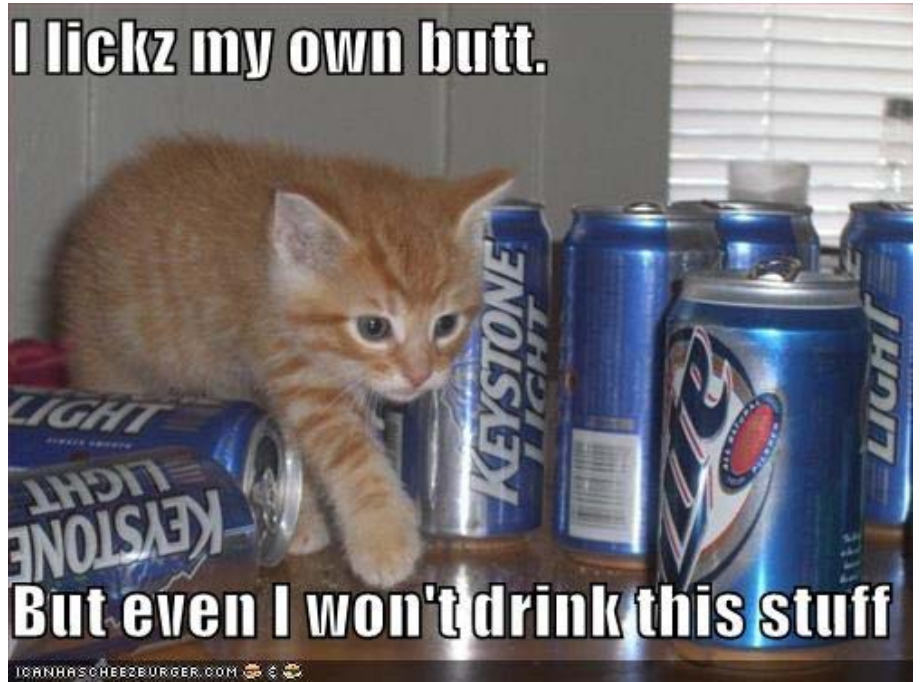
